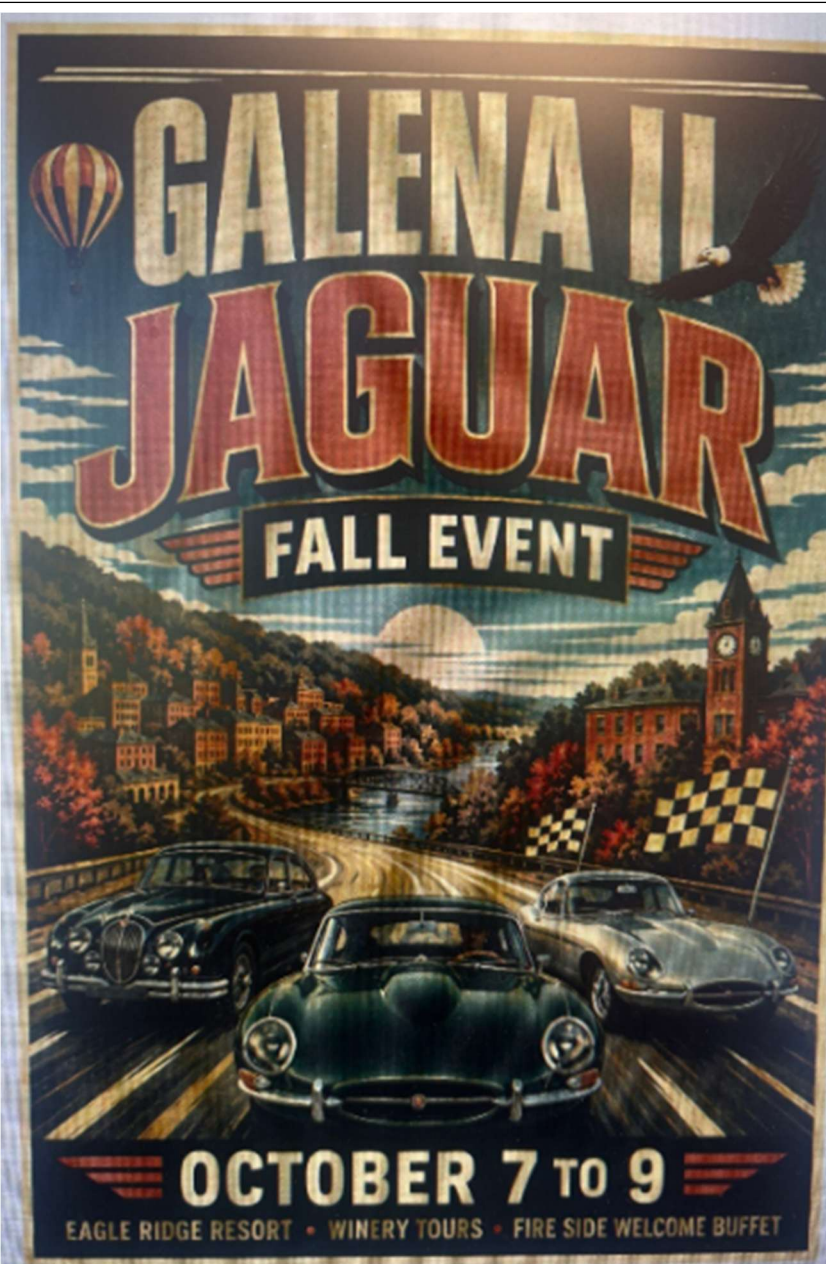

Herbert Austin and Frederick Wolseley had been successfully designing and building sheep shearing machinery for 30 years. The issue they faced was demand for these machines was quite seasonal. Considering they already had mechanical expertise Austin reasoned automobile production would be a good way to provide a stable year-round income.

Automobiles at this time were the toys of the wealthy and famous, a fact not lost upon Herbert Austin. The Austin Motor Company went straight for the top of the market and was quite successful producing large, high quality luxury touring cars. At the start of WWI Austin was producing 1000 cars per year with a modest workforce, however converting to wartime materials required a tenfold increase in workers.

Following cessation of hostilities new issues faced the company. The luxury car market was gone, at least for the time being, and the large wartime workforce was no longer needed. About this same time the middle class was getting interested in the idea of private transportation but was stuck with a motorcycle and sidecar or a three wheeled cycle car. Herbert Austin decided he could do better. He had seen the wisdom of the Model T in the United States and believed he could achieve the same success. The result was the Austin 7, so named because its 696cc four-cylinder engine had a rating of 7.2hp. When launched in 1922 it sold for £225, which was about the same as a motorcycle and sidecar combination. Public response was tremendous. By 1926 the engine had been enlarged slightly and the price dropped to £145 killing off sidecar and cycle cars for good.

Although primarily aimed at the home market the Seven became important on a world-wide scale. It was built under license in France, Germany, and Japan. In addition, rolling chassis were exported to Australia and the United States to have bodies attached. Jaguar's roots are also firmly connected to the Seven. Before becoming a full-scale car manufacturer Jaguar rebodied the Austin Seven chassis to become the Austin Swallow. The up-market styling and two-tone color scheme with a low price of £175 proved very successful for Jaguar, selling 3500 cars.

When production ended in 1939 more than 290,000 Sevens had been built. Even Herbert Austin could not have envisioned that success!
